



STATE CONVENTION

August 11, 2007

Salt Lake County Council Chambers

- A. Call to order at 8:30 by David Perry opening with “AMERICA” lead by Sheryl Fluckiger, Pledge of Allegiance lead by Craig Laurence and prayer by David Hinton.

- B. State Chairman, Frank Fluckiger welcomed the delegates and guests with the purpose of the State Convention as:
 - 1. Even years to confirm the slate of candidates to represent the Constitution Party of Utah in the State and National elections.
 - 2. Odd years to elect the State Officers and amend the State by laws when necessary.

- C. Speakers:
 - 1. Stephen Pratt, Liberty and Learning Instructor, gave a presentation based on the Constitution Party principle that GOD is sovereign and utilizing historical government pamphlets to affirm this.
 - 2. Scott Bradley, 2006 CPU candidate to the U.S. Senate, referred to J.R.Tolken books and the quest for power leading to no faith, no trust, and no caring for others; but to achieve liberty and freedom requires sacrifice.
 - 3. Jim Noorlander, 2006 CPU candidate Utah 3rd U.S. Congressional District, his personal history of following the Constitution and finding a political party with principles that follow the Constitution.
 - 4. Andre Campos, Arizona/Utah Coordinator of the Ron Paul for President 2008 campaign, presented Ron Paul’s platform and welcomed individual support.
 - 5. Charles Jones III, Brigadier General USAF, Retired; Chairman of the National Veterans Coalitions, spoke, via video, the search for a political party that would uphold the Constitution and the initial proposal of retired Generals to form their own party. The decision of organizing veterans and joining with the Constitution Party to further the “fight” for the Constitution.

- D. Update
 - 1. Jeff Case, Constitution National Committee for Radio Ad Campaign, noted the need for funding for ads to inform the public of negative U.S. legislation leading to the North American Coalition and the Patriot Act.
 - 2. Craig Laurence, 2007 candidate for Lehi City Council, noted that he had learned from his last campaign the need to reach all the voters and to work as a team with like-minded candidates to win the election.

- E. Reldon White, State Treasurer gave the annual Financial Report.
- F. Frank Fluckiger, State Chairman, called for nominations for the offices of State Chair, State Vice-Chair, State Secretary and State Treasurer.
 - 1. Nominations and seconds for State Chair = Frank Flukiger; State Vice-Chair = David Perry; State Secretary = Judith Brown; State Treasurer = Reldon White.
 - 2. The delegates unanimously accepted the slate as presented.
- G. Final statements:
 - 1. Mark Hudson, spoke on Constitutional Survival.
 - 2. Robert Brown, www.KNOWYOURRINO.COM, noted this was set up to defeat candidates who said yea to the Constitution but whose actions were Anti-Constitution.
 - 3. The National Committee Meeting will be in Council Bluffs, Iowa.
